# 2.1.5 Lost Property Policy

## Introduction

South Coast Baptist College is committed to providing an excellent environment for students. The College uniform is valued as a means of helping students experience a sense of belonging and shared purpose, developing responsibility and preparing students for later life in the workforce. From time to time student uniform along with other personal items is misplaced. In order to value SCBC uniforms and personal belongings the following policy has been developed.

# **Purpose**

This policy provides direction relating to Lost Property at South Coast Baptist College. This includes all College Uniform and privately owned items found on the College premises.

# Scope

The Lost Property Policy is intended to apply to all students, parents and staff.

### **Procedure**

- 1. Lost Property found on the College premises should be returned to the owner directly if able to be identified.
- 2. Lost Property not able to be returned to the owner should be delivered to Student Services.
- 3. The property kept in Student Services will be stored in appropriate categories for ease of processing.
- 4. Any property that can be attributed to a particular student, parent or staff member will be returned to them.
- 5. Students/parents/staff seeking particular items are welcome to view the lost items in Student Services and reclaim their belongings. An email can also be sent to lostproperty@scbc.wa.edu.au.
- 6. Items that can't be attributed to a current SCBC student, parent or staff member will be made available for any parent to take and make use at the end of each Term. Parents

will be encouraged to take only those items that they would be able to use directly for their children.

7. The items remaining will either be discarded, retained in Student Services or donated.

### **Notes**

Lost Property is dealt with through an honesty system. While every effort is made to ensure property is returned to the rightful owner, SCBC can't guarantee the actions of other members in the community.

Student Services will store lost property as it is.

Money handed in may be used at the discretion of staff to support students.

### **Review**

This Policy will be reviewed bi-annually as part of South Coast Baptist College's cycle of review of all Policies.
