Position Summary

We are seeking applications for an enthusiastic Music Teacher for a part-time (0.8 FTE) 4 days per week, part-time contract teaching position, for Term 4 of the 2024 academic year. This role involves teaching Pre-Primary to Year 6 students in the Primary School at South Coast Baptist College, located in the southern suburb of Waikiki, Western Australia. The Primary School currently has 657 students from kindergarten through to Year 6, with a dedicated team of teachers, teaching assistants, and administrators. The College draws students from many of the surrounding suburbs including Waikiki, Rockingham, Safety Bay, Warnbro, Baldivis, Port Kennedy, Shoalwater, and Cooloongup.

Areas of Responsibility

Curriculum Development:

- Teach music curriculum to Primary School students from Pre-Primary to Year 6.
- Organise and arrange some musical items for Junior Primary classes for the end-or year Christmas Assembly.

Professional Development:

- Attend weekly staff and professional learning team meetings.
- Demonstrate a commitment to lifelong learning as part of the teaching profession, evidenced by development of programs and teaching methods.

Program Development:

Implement and develop the music program over the final term of the academic year.
